

Sermon Rewind – August 21, 2006

Happy Monday. On Sabbath we learned that “Holy Ground” encounters with God happen when we 1) know that God is ABOVE us, 2) realize WHO God is, 3) know that God is FOR us, and finally, 4) trust that God is WITH us. Take a look at the week ahead. In which of these four ways do you need to know God this week? Today? Go to Him in prayer right now and tell Him about it.

For those who are facing some major trials and need to know that God is FOR you and WITH you this week, rewind to Hebrews 2:18. *“For because He Himself [in His humanity] has suffered in being tempted (tested and tried), He is able [immediately] to **run to the cry** of (assist, relieve) those who are being tempted and tested and tried [and who therefore are being exposed to suffering].”* (Amplified Version)

Remember, God is not oblivious to our trials and heartaches. God SEES, God HEARS, God CARES, and God DELIVERS. Worship Him freely and behold His wonders in your life.
